Grand Prix du Vin Suisse: The winery Leukersonne becomes 'Swiss Winery of the Year 2024' and defends its title from last year!

This has never happened before in the history of the Grand Prix du Vin Suisse (GPVS): Damian and Fabienne Seewer's 'Leukersonne' winery in Susten in the Upper Valais defends the prestigious 'Winery of the Year' special prize.

Bern, Friday, 18 October 2024, More than 560 representatives of the Swiss wine scene, politicians, press representatives and wine lovers met on Friday, 18 October 2024, in the Kursaal Bern, at the annual highlight of the entire Swiss wine industry, to celebrate the 18th Grand Prix du Vin Suisse at the grand 'Gala of Swiss Wine'.

For the first time in the history of the GPVS, the Leukersonne winery in Susten, run by Damian and Fabienne Seewer, was able to defend the prestigious title of 'Winery of the Year'.

The 'Prix Vinissimo White' went to Domaines Chevaliers from Salgesch and the 'Prix Vinissimo Red' was awarded to the Leukersonne winery. The 'Prix Vin Bio' went to the Weinschmiede winery from Salgesch for their Götterrank 2022, while the 'Prix Découverte' went to Andrea and Michael Weingartner from Hünenberg, who have been vinifying wines in Ticino for over 20 years.

18 cantons represented - Chasselas and Pinot Noir dominate

In its 18th edition, the GPVS is once again a reflection of the whole Swiss viticulture. The cantons with the biggest vineyards surfaces also provide the largest contingents of submitted wines.

The Valais dominates with 1,183 wines submitted, followed by the canton of Vaud with 611 wines and German-speaking Switzerland with a total of 439 wines. A total of 18 of the 26 Swiss cantons are represented with wines at the award, two more cantons than in the past.

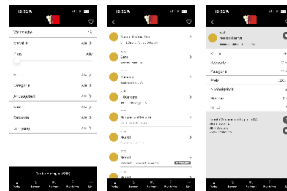
Although more red wines than white wines were submitted for the 18th edition of the award, single-varietal white wines are traditionally the strongest category. Valais varieties such as Heida dominate here, Petite Arvine and Johannisberg (Syvaner). Overall, however, Chasselas and Pinot Noir are the strongest varieties in this competition.
